Important Precautions:

- Read ALL instructions before assembling.
- Use caution when assembling, net opens very fast.
- Never use where property or bystanders may be harmed.
- Should only be used for the purpose it was intended.
- Always store indoors in a dry place when not in use.

- (2) Metal support poles (2 connected sections per pole)
- (1) Support pole nylon bag

Opening the Rebound Net:

1. Prepare to set up the Rebound Net in a wide-open area.
2. Unzip the nylon carrying case and remove the Rebound Net.
3. Using both hands, grasp the Rebound Net firmly and remove the elastic strap that holds the Rebound Net together (fig. 5).
4. Using both hands, toss the Rebound Net far away from your body into an open area (fig 6). Use caution, the Rebound Net springs open quickly.

Setting Up the Rebound Net:

1. Begin by assembling the two metal support poles (fig 7). Once assembled each pole will have a metal tip at either end.
2. Take one pole and insert the pole tip through one of the metal grommets in the top of the net frame and cover the pole tip with the rubber cap (fig. 8). Insert the pole tip on the other end of the pole into the metal grommet of the frame on the ground and cover the tip with the rubber cap (fig. 9). Repeat this process on the other side of the net using the second pole.

NOTE: There are two grommet positions to choose from when putting the poles into the top of the net frame. The upper grommet will put the net in a layed back position that lofts the ball back to the player. This is ideal for beginners. The lower grommet position stands the net upright providing a more direct return for advanced players.

3. Tighten the crossing straps at the back of the Rebound Net by pulling on the loose strap ends near each buckle (fig. 10). This will stabilize the net reducing side-to-side movement when in use.

Folding the Rebound Net:

1. Carefully remove the rubber caps from the ends of the support poles and remove the pole tips from the grommets in the net face and base. Disassemble the poles and put the poles back into the nylon pole bag.
2. With the Rebound Net (including the base) standing on edge, grab the top of the Rebound Net using both hands. Put your foot on the bottom of the Rebound Net near the GAMMA logo. Push down so the middle of the Rebound Net bows away from you (fig. 11). Continue this motion until your hands are below the level of your waist, then pull the top of the net toward your left side until the net appears to be in a figure-8 shape (fig. 12). Fold the net straight down to the ground (fig. 13).
3. Fold one of the circles formed in the figure-8 over on top of the other returning the Rebound Net to its original 3 1/2' folded circular form (fig. 14).
4. Holding the folded Rebound Net firmly, secure the black elastic strap around the net to hold it so it will not spring open (fig. 15).
5. Lay the carrying case flat on the ground, place the Rebound Net and support pole bag in the carrying case, then zip the carrying case closed.

The RA# must be clearly marked on the outside of the shipping carton being returned. All returns must be shipped prepaid by the customer to GAMMA. Please retain the original shipping carton and packing materials for any future shipments. GAMMA will not be responsible for EQUIPMENT which is not returned in the original undamaged packaging.
